Become an Adopter of Simultaneous Policy (SP) by telling politicians how they can earn your vote.

Background: Simpol International's aim is to convince all politicians, in all democratically elected governments, that it is in their best interests to pledge to their electorates that they will implement SP, when the opportunity arises. This means that they will abandon the current competitive mode of conducting international relations in favour of cooperation with other nations in solving the problems of a globalised world.

To be certain of achieving its goal in NZ, Simpol-NZ has to persuade sufficient national politicians that they will gain electoral advantage if they sign the SP Pledge - and that they will face the risk of electoral disadvantage if they don't. Simpol does this by lobbying sitting politicians, political parties and electoral candidates. The method of choice is the written letter.

In modern democracies, where national politicians' powers to legislate are so restricted by the realities of international competition within a globalised economy, political parties have difficulties in distinguishing themselves in the eyes of the electorate. Consequently, elections are won by ever decreasing margins. If Simpol-NZ can persuade politicians that it can deliver an electoral bias of just one percent to the swing vote, our goal will be within our grasp. There is no other way in which you can use your vote to exert greater leverage than that outlined below.

Signify that you adopt SP by writing to the politicians you wish to influence - now!

Please compose your own letter, or modify, or post as is, a downloaded version of our standard suggested letters as set out under "downloads" in our menu.

When you have written your letter, please make a hard copy, which you sign and post (no postage required to MPs) and at the same time, if you wish, email a copy to simpol@simpol-nz.org On receipt of a copy of your letter we will take it that you wish to Adopt SP and that we should keep you informed, through newsletters and our Website, of the politicians who commit to SP.
